"LOVE LIFE" TRUST FUND

Establishing a trust fund to assist area families was always a goal since initial planning of the *Cancer Support & Resource Program* first began in 2006. Realistically, it was a long term goal, postponed until charitable status could be obtained. This goal was unexpectedly realized in the summer of 2008 through the generous support from two memorial golf tournaments.

This "Love Life" Trust Fund was named in honour of Lynne Love and the support given to establish it by her husband Doug, friend Linda & their golf tournament Committee.

As donations to this trust are received, available funds will assist area cancer patients with necessities like food, rent, medicine, therapy, or even day care on treatment days.

All the applications received will be impartially reviewed and confidentially disbursed by the Trust Fund. And it is the hope of the CSRP that this will be a continuing support to benefit all of the Norfolk residents who may require it.



"GEORGE'S NIGHT OUT"

As part of the "Love Life" Trust Fund, a Social Events Program named "*George's Night Out*" was also created in 2008. It honours George Baldock and three years of CSRP support from his wife Sue, son Sihlor, their families and their golf tournament Committee.

Based upon a similar program that provided 'couple time' for them during George's cancer treatment this will also offer couples or families opportunities to enjoy area sporting events, shows, or dining during cancer treatment.

Donations of funds *or tickets* to this Trust will provide monthly activities for those cancer patients who apply to this "*George's Night Out*" Program.

THE "KIMMIE" DOLL DONOR PROGRAM

Created by American cancer survivor, Kim Goebel, these dolls with a removable scarf, two wigs and storey book assist parents to explain the changes caused by chemotherapy to young children. While Kim Goebel is missed by all, her legacy lives on in these dolls appearing for the first time in Canada through the CSRP "*Kimmie Doll Donor Program*" .

These doll kits are available in several nationalities or languages for cancer patients and families. An individual or group donation of \$50 to this "*Kimmie*" *Doll Donor Program* places a therapeutic doll where it is needed the most.
